<b>ACCOMMODATIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Suites with 4 bedrooms, each with one queen bed Suite has two bathrooms, shared sitting and kitchen area with fridge and stove. Coffee maker, basic dishes and cutlery for 4 people.</li> <li>• <b>Please indicate when registering the name of whom you will share.</b></li> <li>• If you are not able to share the queen bed, we are allowed to bring in extra cots or a foam mattress. If a group of friends share a suite, they are free to make their own sleeping arrangements; they can then divide the cost of the suite between residents.</li> </ul>
<b>MEALS</b>	Upon arrival on Thursday, pizza will be available, or restaurants are close by. Lunch and dinner served each day in the university cafeteria.
