

What is a Cursillo of Cursillos?

It is a Cursillo, (meaning short course), and as such is the means to facilitate, for those who live it, a channel for the ideas and the fire in our hearts which enables us to carry out those ideas.

It is NOT a Cursillo weekend as we know it. *"It would be wrong if a person attends only to find ideas or topics to enable them to know more about Cursillo without having the proper attitude to carry them out and it would also be a deception for those who are only looking for a spiritual push to motivate them to continue in what they already do, thinking that what they are doing is the best way."* (Miguel Sureda, *Cursillo of Cursillos, Mallorca*)

Its purpose is to enable us all to come to a deeper and more accurate understanding of the **mentality** and the **method** and to generate the enthusiasm and perseverance necessary for putting the ideas into practice in the marketplace of our everyday lives. To be good stewards of the gift of the Charism of Cursillo, we not only have to do all in our power to preserve and guard it, we need to know just what it is we are guarding.

The Cursillo of Cursillos is used regularly in Mallorca and what is to be presented is the same as that which is presented in Mallorca, designed and authored by Eduardo Bonnín and the Mallorcan School of Leaders.

Those who participate in a C of C come away with a renewed understanding and a renewed commitment and above all, a new enthusiasm.

The Cursillo of Cursillos is run just like a Cursillo weekend with:

**rollos, group discussion, an opportunity to ask questions
and an experience of the friendship that is Cursillo.**

The topics were chosen by Eduardo many years ago to help those who are living the method and mentality of the Movement to be effective and successful in the work of evangelizing the environments with the simple Gospel message, "God loves you".

As Jesus called the first disciples, in response to their question, "Master, where do you live?" He said, "Come and See". That same call echoes down the ages, and to us as Cursillistas who listen to the same Spirit who spoke to the disciples and gave the gift of Cursillo to Eduardo Bonnín, we are called to follow in the footsteps of Jesus and those same disciples. He says to us as He said to them, "COME AND SEE".
